Adoption Statement

Mendip Local Plan Part I: Strategy and Policies

Notice is hereby given that Mendip District Council adopted its Local Plan Part I: Strategy and Policies on 15th December 2014 in accordance with the above regulations.

Mendip Local Plan Part I: Strategy and Policies is the first part of the Local Plan and replaces those 'saved' policies of the Mendip District Local Plan 2002 - 2011 as listed in Appendix 1 of the adopted Local Plan Part I.

The Mendip Local Plan Part I sets out an overarching framework for the future of the District to 2029 and comprises a long-term spatial vision, strategic objectives and spatial strategy. It also contains strategies for the principal towns and local development policies, along with a monitoring and implementation framework.

The Local Plan Part I has been subject to examination by an independent Inspector appointed by the Secretary of State. The adopted Plan incorporates modifications recommended by the Inspector as set out in the Appendix to the Inspector's Report.

Any person who is aggrieved by the Mendip Local Plan Part I may make an application to the High Court under Section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 on the grounds that the document is not within the appropriate power and/or procedural requirements have not been complied with.

Any such application should be made promptly and in any event no later than the end of the six week challenge period, starting with the date on which the plan was adopted (15th December 2014).
